

PUPPY SUPPLIES CHECKLIST



THE ESSENTIALS:

- A crate - just big enough for the puppy to stand up, turn around, and stretch out in comfortably
- Bedding - old towels or blankets that you don't mind getting destroyed
- Puppy food
- Training treats - something pea-size, soft, and chewy
- At least one food-dispensing puzzle toy, like a Kong
- Some tasty chews, like bully sticks, pig ears, or Nylabones
- At least 2-3 squeaky and/or plush toys (the pup will probably shred them. That's okay. It's what toys are for!)
- Buckle collar - check the fit: you should be able to snugly fit two fingers under the collar when the pup is wearing it
- Leash - regular 4-6ft (1.5-2m) cotton, nylon, or leather, non-retractable
- Pet mess cleaner - make sure it says "enzymatic" or "enzyme-based"
- Paper towels or rags
- Dog nail clippers
- Food and water bowls
- Poop bags (plastic grocery bags work fine) and a poop scoop if you have a yard

VERY NICE TO HAVE:

- Exercise pen and/or baby gates
- Wearable training-treat pouch
- Long training leash - about 20ft (6m)
- Harness
